Good Afternoon,

Some stubborn inflation data for February has hit the pause button on recent stock market advances. Correspondingly, the interest rate on the US Ten-Year Treasury has crept back up to nearly 4.3%, where it was a month ago. Most analysts believe inflation is still trending lower, despite the February numbers, and that the Fed is likely to cut interest rates at their June meeting. The Fed meets next week, and we expect Chair Powell to be asked about "market exuberance" at his post-meeting press conference.

I was thinking about historic boxing rematches and some great ones come to mind. Ali vs. Frazier, Leonard vs. Duran, and Robinson vs. LaMotta were among the all-time great rivalries between legendary fighters in their primes. Now contrast those competitions with our pending heavyweight matchup for the President of the United States scheduled for early November. A rematch? Yes. Legendary fighters in their prime? Not so much. The Republicans will send out Donald Trump for the third consecutive time despite losing the popular vote in 2016 and 2020. The Democrats bring Joe Biden, the oldest presidential nominee ever – breaking his own record from 2020. The sport of politics needs some new contenders.
