Stocks are trying to rally this past week but have a way to go to make up for the poor start to August. Bond yields have come down slightly from their recent highs giving bond owners a welcome break and stock owners encouragement. Economic data show the economy continues to grow at a reasonable pace, even with higher interest rates. We get key inflation data soon and the Federal Reserve meets later in September to decide their next move. Stock and bond markets hope they are done raising rates in their fight against inflation.
